**Job Title:** Assistant Livestock Manager

**Permanent position:** start date between March 1 and April 15

**Regular work hours:** Mon-Fri, 8-9 hours/day, with weekend chores rotation with other WHF staff. 2 paid days off earned per month of completed employment. Earned days off do not roll over year-to-year.

**Compensation:** \$550-650/week DOE, +\$200/month worth of meat, some vegetables from the garden, on-farm housing with private bedroom, and shared common spaces.

This position is for someone with at least 2 years of previous livestock farming experience who is dedicated to pasture-based, regenerative, meat production being a significant part of their life. Our Assistant Livestock Manager reports directly to the Farm Manager.

For the 2022 season we plan to raise about 40 beef cattle, 80 pigs, 1500 meat chickens, and 200 turkeys.

**Position expectations:**

- Assist Farm Manager in designing and implementing weekly & daily work lists
- Livestock handling and moving animals within and between pastures
- Set up, move, repair, and store fencing
- Maintain, monitor, and repair water systems
- Transport livestock with a trailer
- Support the Farm Manager in implementing daily workflow and managing and teaching other farm staff
- Assist the Farm Manager with treatment of sick and injured animals as well as regular preventative care
- Monitor pasture and animal health - suggest modifications to Farm Manager
- Assist with pasture management, including mowing, weedwhacking, and brush clearing
- Assist with livestock & pasture management record keeping
- Work with Farm Property Manager to maintain the attractive aesthetic of the property
- Must prioritize organization and implement new strategies

**Candidate requirements:**

- Experience working with and leading a team
- Must be an effective and compassionate teacher, especially within an experiential learning environment
- Ability to operate basic farm equipment safely and effectively
- Ability to operate manual transmission vehicles safely and effectively
- Ability to perform outdoor physical labor in all weather conditions

- Ability to lift 50 pounds
- Valid US driver's license in good standing
- Willing to help with emergencies during non-regular hours.
- Must be able to respectfully and kindly communicate with other staff, neighbors, and contractors
- Understanding of regenerative livestock practices
